Bernstein's West Side Story at Core of Planned CD

Fort Lauderdale - The Florida Philharmonic (FPO) will perform an all Bernstein program on Thursday, May 17 at 8 PM at the Kravis Center for the Performing Arts and Friday, May 18 5 Saturday, May 19, at 8 PM at the Broward Center for the Performing Arts.

The FPO and Music Director James Judd will be performing with acclaimed pianist Jean-Louis Steuerman in the Florida Philharmonic's season finale concert that Showcases monumental works such as:

Overture to Candide, Symphonic Dances', Age of Anxiety." James Judd and the FPO will record the performance for NAXOS as the first of several Bernstein discs.

Bernstein's Overture: Candide began as an operatic adaptation of Voltaire's Candide, a satirical view of 18th-century Europe that appeared on the stage in the early 1950s. The composition was written for Candide, the Broadway musical that proved to be a little too sophisticated for Broadway audiences. Although, the original musical disappeared, with a brief revival in 1973, Bernstein's music gained critical acclaim.
